The Market hours are from 5:00pm to 9:00pm. You will be allowed to set up as early as 2pm and **you must provide your own table and chairs**. You are allowed to sell food items such as hot dogs, hamburgers, pizza, snacks, and etc. as well as crafts. Application and fee deadline is June 24th. Water, electricity and restrooms are available. No motorized vehicles permitted off-road in the park. Absolutely no vehicles are allowed on any bridges, trails or berms. Parking spaces will be provided for all Vendors. **NO fireworks of any kind are permitted on park grounds except for city authorized professional displays.** All trash must be picked up and booth must be left in the condition it was in at time of rental. Any problems must be reported to a staff employee immediately. All instructions from staff employee must be followed. Reservations for booths must be made in advance at City Hall, Monday-Friday 8:00 am to 5:00 pm. The City assumes no liability for the use of the park or any facilities located in the park. **ALL RESERVATIONS REQUIRE SIGNATURE. NO REFUNDS!!! The City is not responsible for lost/left behind items.**
