City of Richmond Hill sets dates for large item pick-up

Richmond Hill- City officials announced today that Richmond Hill will celebrate Georgia Cities Week from April 22-28 this year. Georgia Cities Week is an annual celebration sponsored by the Georgia Municipal Association to highlight the contributions Cities make to the lives of their residents. One of the most highly anticipated activities this year is the curbside pick-up of large items not normally picked up by the City. See the City's Facebook or Website for a full schedule of activities.

This year, the pick-up will take place throughout the City on April 22- 28. See the neighborhood schedule and other information below:

Monday (April 24) – Large item trash pick-up in the following areas:

Mulberry, Richmond Place, Blueberry, Camellia Street, Rosemont Street, Carter Street, Rushing Street, Forest Street, Clark Street, Live Oak, White Oak and Ponderosa

Wednesday (April 26) - Large item pick-up in the following areas:

Piercefield, Teal Lake, Main Street, Bisbon Hall, Sterling Creek, Sterling Woods, Cypress Point, Richmond Hill Plantation-Port Royal and Creekside

Friday (April 28) – Large item pick-up in the following areas:

Richmond Heights, Parkside, Bottoms, Cherokee, Port Drive, Melrose, Richmond Hill Plantation and Turtle Hill

This opportunity is available for Richmond Hill current water account users in residential zoning areas only. Curbside pick-up will include large items such as appliances, furniture and other bulky items not normally picked up by the regular trash service. All City residents should place their items on the curb by 7 a.m. the morning of scheduled pick-up.

The following items will not be collected: tires, hazardous waste items, paint, refrigerators, freezers, oil or oil based product, grease products, batteries, gas or gas based products, lawnmowers, Freon or Freon based products.

Again, residents are reminded that if their subdivision is scheduled for large item trash pick-up, the items need to be placed curbside no later than 7 a.m. the morning of scheduled pick-up.

Subdivisions will be serviced once only on the day indicated. Yard waste will be picked up on the regular scheduled days.
