

Richmond Hill Police Department
Rules for Range Use

1. Only authorized department/unit training will be conducted on the range. (No individuals are authorized use of the range.)
2. Requesting agencies will complete a Range Request form at least 14 days prior to their scheduled training event. Training "emergencies" will be handled on a case by case basis.
3. Scheduling will be on a first come, first served basis. The Richmond Hill Police Department and the GPSTC-Savannah will have scheduling priority.
4. If an agency wishes to use the turning target system, they must coordinate at least 14 days prior to the scheduled training event to ensure that an operator will be available.
5. The range and facilities will be inspected at the beginning and end of each training day. Be sure to allow at least 15 minutes for each inspection.
6. It is the using agency's responsibility to ensure that the items on the Range Inspection Form are complete.
7. The using agency must be capable of contacting the Richmond Hill Police Department and the Bryan County 911 Center via telephone or radio in the event of an emergency.
8. Any injuries will be reported immediately to the on duty RHPD supervisor. Contact dispatch or RHPD to notify the supervisor.
9. Rifles and shotguns are not authorized for use on the pistol range.
10. All training must be conducted under the supervision of a certified firearms instructor.
11. All shooters will wear hearing and eye protection while on the firing line.
12. No smoking inside of any building or structure (including bathrooms) or within 50 feet of ammunition storage areas.

Treat all firearms as if they are loaded!
Always keep your firearm pointed in a safe direction!
Keep your finger off of the trigger until ready to shoot!
