



Please be advised of the following guidelines for the placement of campaign signs within the City of Richmond Hill per the provisions of the Signage Regulations within the Richmond Hill Unified Development Ordinance:

1) Duration of Campaign Signage

- Campaign signs are allowed to be placed within the City upon the opening day of qualification of candidates and shall be removed within 10 days after the election of all candidates to office.

2) Number Allowed on the Property

- There is no limit on the number of campaign signs per property.

3) Size and Height of Campaign Signage

- Campaign signs located on single-family residential, townhouse, condominium, or manufactured home lots shall not exceed 6 square feet in sign face area and 5 feet in height
- Campaign signs located on multi-family, mobile home park, or other nonresidential use property shall not exceed 32 square feet in sign face area and 8 feet in height.

4) Location of Campaign Signage

- All campaign signs shall be located on private property at least 10 feet from any street right-of-way line. Campaign signs shall be no closer to the right-of-way than adjacent permanent signs in the area. All campaign signs shall be located at least 10 feet from any side or rear property line and the pavement edge of a driveway.
- Campaign signs are not allowed to be placed within or over a public street right-of-way or private street easement.
- A campaign sign shall not be affixed to any tree, utility pole, or official traffic sign or structure.
- A campaign sign shall be erected and maintained only with the permission of the owner of the property upon which the sign is located.

5) Permit Requirements

- The permit requirements of the *Signage Regulations* do not apply to campaign signs; therefore, these signs do not require a permit or fee.
