# Recovery After Debby



## CITY ASSESSMENTS

The City has been visiting impacted areas to assess damaged properties. These assessments will identify any potential structural damage to residents' homes. Residents should not be alarmed if they see City vehicles driving through neighborhoods, taking pictures, and then stopping back by to provide letters and post placards on properties.

While some repairs will not require a permit, others may. Even during a disaster homeowners and business must obtain any necessary permits. These regulations help ensure the safety of the resident and that the work is being performed by a qualified contractor and done properly. While the permit is required, the City is waiving all permit and inspections fees for work repairing or replacing features damaged by TS Debby.

When hiring a contractor always:

- Ask for references and check them.
- Get written estimates and don't pay anything upfront.
- Check to make sure they have a valid business license, liability insurance, and workers comp insurance.
